Friday, April 28

5:45AM	Meet at Argyle Secondary: Check in with Chaperone Teacher
6:00AM	Load coach buses: luggage on one bus, instruments on other bus Students can choose with bus to travel on, but must stay on the SAME bus <i>* Make sure you have everything you need! Snacks, pillows, charging devices, headphones, lunch money etc.</i>
6:30AM	Coach buses depart for Sun Peaks, BC
12:00PM	Arrival, unload & check in at Cahilty Lodge <i>* all hands on deck to help with unloading the coach buses!</i> <i>* Chaperone teachers will distribute room keys upon arrival</i>
12:30PM	Explore the village and buy lunch (move in groups of 4 minimum!)
Instrument Workshops – The times listed below are when the workshops BEGIN. You must be READY before the workshop time. We may decide to walk as a group depending on the location of the workshop – please listen for instructions on the day of. When you are NOT in a workshop, you may explore the village in minimum groups of 4.	
2:00PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Woodwind workshop (flute, clarinet, oboe) at The Annex – bring instrument & massed band music - Percussion workshop at the Sun Peaks Grand & Conference Centre – bring instruments, mallets, and massed band music
3:00PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Saxophone workshop at The Annex – bring instrument & massed band music - Electric bass workshop at the Sun Peaks Grand & Conference Centre – bring instrument, patch cord and massed band music
4:00PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Brass workshop at The Annex – bring instrument & massed band music - Upright bass workshop at the Sun Peaks Grand & Conference Centre – bring instrument and massed band music
6:00PM	Meet in hotel lobby to walk to Mantle's Restaurant
7:00PM	Register for Scavenger Hunt at the Sun Peaks Grand & Conference Centre (if you wish to participate)
7:30PM / TBC	Joint activity with Windsor Secondary – please listen for instructions at dinner time regarding this evening activity.
10:30PM	Lights out / Room Check! <i>* Students must not leave their room (unless there is an emergency) after their chaperone room checks.</i>

7:30AM	Meet in the Hotel lobby and walk to Cahilty Creek Kitchen (breakfast)
9:50AM	Concert Band – meet in lobby with instruments, music, and everything needed for the festival performance (in concert dress – all black formal) Jazz Band – can be in informal wear. Jazz band students can also watch other performing groups while Concert Band is warming up. Please be the Grand Ballroom before 11AM to watch the Concert Band performance
10:00AM	Concert Band – to Sun Peaks Grand & Conference Centre to warm up, performance and receive clinic
12:00PM	Meet in the Hotel lobby and walk to Cahilty Creek Kitchen (lunch) You may change out of your performance clothes and return your instruments to your hotel rooms before meeting in the lobby (unless you are in jazz band!)
1:25PM	Jazz Band – meet in meet in lobby with instruments, music, and everything needed for the festival performance (in concert dress – all black formal) Concert Band – can be in informal wear. Concert Band students can watch other performing groups at this time. Depending of space availability, please be at the Annex at 2PM to watch Jazz Band perform!
1:40PM	Jazz Band at The Annex for warm up, performance, and clinic
3:00PM	Return to hotel – Students who are in formal wear can change into casual wear and bring instruments back to their hotel room
3:40PM	Meet in Lobby to walk to Sun Peaks Grand & Conference Centre – watch scheduled performance (Enver Creek Grade 9 Concert Band) at 4PM
5:15PM	Meet in the Hotel lobby to walk to Cahilty Creek Kitchen (dinner) Some time to relax after dinner ends
8:00PM	Meet in the Hotel lobby to walk to Sun Peaks Grand & Conference Centre and line up for evening concert
8:45PM	Watch Gala Festival Concert
10:30PM	Lights out / Room Check! <i>* Students must not leave their room (unless there is an emergency) after their chaperone room checks.</i>
